# Welcome to the Current Middle Ages!

The Society for Creative Anachronism (SCA) is an international non-profit volunteer educational organization. The SCA is devoted to the research and re-creation of pre-seventeenth century skills, arts, combat, culture, and employing knowledge of history to enrich the lives of participants through events, demonstrations, and other educational presentations and activities.

Members of the SCA study and take part in a variety of activities, including combat, archery, equestrian activities, costuming, cooking, metalwork, woodworking, music, dance, calligraphy, fiber arts, and much more. If it was done in the Middle Ages or Renaissance, odds are you'll find someone in the SCA interested in recreating it.

What makes the SCA different from a Humanities 101 class is the **active** participation in the learning process. To learn about the clothing of the period, you research it, then sew and wear it yourself. To learn about combat, you put on armor (which you may have built yourself) and learn how to defeat your opponent. To learn to brew, you make (and sample!) your own wines, meads and beers.

You will frequently hear SCA participants describe the SCA as recreating the Middle Ages "as they ought to have been." In some ways this is true – we choose to use indoor plumbing, heated halls, and sewing machines. In the dead of winter, we have more to eat than King's venison, salt pork and dried tubers. However, a better description is that we *selectively recreate* the culture, choosing elements of the culture that interest and attract us.

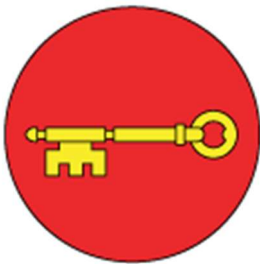

Happy holidays to one and all! I hope you all are having a safe and happy holiday season! The Barony has been busy during these holiday months. In November, we held our Baronial Birthday event. It was such a good feeling to see each other again in person, and the excitement that I saw from everyone was so uplifting to see. I think all of us felt a bit of emptiness not being able to sit together for feast. The feast is such an integral part of Birthday and not being able to hold the feast was a sad thing for many. But it gives us incentive to come together and work together to demonstrate a safe and responsible environment so that we can serve food again sooner rather than later.

Speaking of events, I am excited to announce to all of you that our 2022 schedule is looking great! We have already received bids on every event except Birthday, and for Birthday we have already approved a bid proposal and we should see the full bid submission by our January Business meeting. The schedule for 2022 also includes a Kingdom event! We have won the bid to host the Spring Crown Tournament in April!! So that means we will be hosting four events in 2022. I would like to talk about each of them here.

In March, (March 19) we are holding Baronial Champions. This event will be combining our A&S event which has been held in January with our traditional Champions event. The event is being stewarded by THL Helena Handbasket, who has been doing a stellar job getting everything organized so far. She has procured the Skyline Activity Center in Idaho Falls. This event has been approved by Kingdom. So keep your eyes open for upcoming information. The online reservation system (SCARS) will be available for pre-registration. I highly encourage you to make use of SCARS, it makes checking in so much easier for everybody involved. I believe that most of the SCARS event registrations will be opened after the first of the year (it makes end of year reporting much easier!) We will announce when pre-registration is open. You will also be seeing more information as it becomes available.

In April, (April 16) the Barony of One Thousand Eyes will be hosting the Kingdom Crown Tournament. I am very excited for this opportunity to showcase our Barony to the Kingdom. I especially want to thank our event stewards, THL Crestina da Brescia and THL Thorston Kvendulfson, for putting together one of the fastest and most complete bids I have seen in a while to get it submitted to Kingdom. The Kingdom accepted our bid and already Crestina and Thorston are hard at work to make this a spectacular event. It will be held in the Exhibit Hall at the Bonneville County

Fairgrounds. SCARS will also be available to pre-register for this event. Again, I highly encourage everybody to pre-register as it is anticipated for this event to be well attended and I want everybody in the Barony to be able to attend. Please plan to attend and help show the Kingdom the glory of our Barony!

In June, (June 9-12) we will be holding Uprising! This event has been submitted to Kingdom for review, so it should be approved shortly. SCARS will also be available to pre-register for this event! Uprising will be held this year one week earlier than typical, so please be aware of that change. Also, it is being shortened by a bit for this year, opening on Thursday. It will be held at the Krupp Scout Hollow camp just North of Rigby. The event stewards are Lady Reina L'archer Renalde and THL Reynhard von Reutte. Planning has already begun and there are many great things in store! Stay tuned to start hearing more once we have full approval.

That leaves us with Baronial Birthday again, to be held in November. As I mentioned, we have approved a bid for it and are just awaiting the final details to make it a full bid submission and then it will start moving forward in the process for approval.

If you have not noticed, that means we have our entire 2022 event schedule laid out already! I am so very appreciative to all of the event stewards for making this happen! Thank you all for answering my request to get our bids in by the end of this year. We now have plenty of time to concentrate on promoting the events to people, new and old, and working to make them as successful as possible. We are going to have a great year! I look forward to wading into 2022, and I hope you all will join me!

Pray heed the august words of Their Majesties, Sean and Nisa, as They announce new policy affecting Our Kingdom

#### Covid Policy Implementation

Sean and Nisa, 47th Monarchs of Glorious Artemisia, and Catherine Anne of Newberry, our Kingdom Seneschal, send greetings throughout the lands.

The SCA Board of Directors has released a policy update related to response to the Covid-19 virus and ways in which we can move forward to safely returning to in-person events once again. This recent policy change is an option that has been made available to the Kingdoms. It is not a Society wide policy change. This is an option that each Kingdom is allowed to implement, or not, depending on each Kingdom's unique circumstances.

To sum up, this policy gives the Kingdoms the option to require proof of Covid vaccinations, or to provide Covid test results showing not detected for the virus within 72 hours of an event. The Crown of Artemisia and the Kingdom Seneschal, together, have decided that we will implement this policy in Artemisia as of our Crown Tourney being held in the Barony of Arn Hold on the weekend of October 16th. This policy will be in effect where permitted by law. Currently, state law in Montana does not permit us to implement this policy in that state. As such our previous mask mandate will remain in effect for events held in the state of Montana.

This is a decision that we feel is in the best interest of our Kingdom and allows us that best opportunity to get back to regularly scheduled events with minimal restrictions. Taking this small effort to minimize potential exposure to the virus will become increasingly important as we move into a season where many of our events will be taking place indoors. The implementation of this policy will supersede our previous mask mandate for events. We will no longer require the populace to wear a mask at events. However, we ask everyone to respect the desire of members of the populace who wish to continue wearing a mask for their increased safety.

We encourage you to read the policy in its entirety. The SCA Board of Directors will have an FAQ to address many of the questions that have already come up about how this policy is to be implemented. We wish to make it very clear that this policy is non-negotiable. If you cannot, or will not, meet the guidelines laid out in this policy, we ask you to consider not coming to an event until you can, or will meet the requirements of having proof of vaccination or a negative covid test. The people sitting a gate, who are asked to verify your adherence to this policy are doing so on a volunteer basis and at the direction of the Crown and Kingdom Seneschal. We will not tolerate anyone coercing the event staff, in any way, into circumventing this policy. There is a very clear expectation here. We ask the populace to respect those expectations without any undue stress or influence upon the people who have been asked to administer this policy.

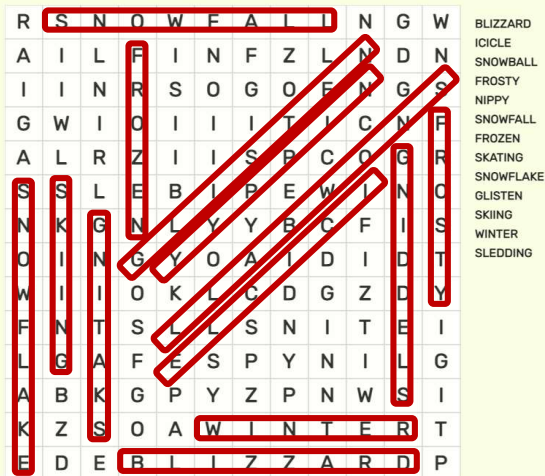
