The Society for Creative Anachronism (SCA) is an international non-profit volunteer educational organization. The SCA is devoted to the research and re-creation of pre-seventeenth century skills, arts, combat, culture, and employing knowledge of history to enrich the lives of participants through events, demonstrations, and other educational presentations and activities.

Members of the SCA study and take part in a variety of activities, including combat, archery, equestrian activities, costuming, cooking, metalwork, woodworking, music, dance, calligraphy, fiber arts, and much more. If it was done in the Middle Ages or Renaissance, odds are you'll find someone in the SCA interested in recreating it.

What makes the SCA different from a Humanities 101 class is the **active** participation in the learning process. To learn about the clothing of the period, you research it, then sew and wear it yourself. To learn about combat, you put on armor (which you may have built yourself) and learn how to defeat your opponent. To learn to brew, you make (and sample!) your own wines, meads and beers.

You will frequently hear SCA participants describe the SCA as recreating the Middle Ages "as they ought to have been." In some ways this is true – we choose to use indoor plumbing, heated halls, and sewing machines. In the dead of winter, we have more to eat than King's venison, salt pork and dried tubers. However, a better description is that we *selectively recreate* the culture, choosing elements of the culture that interest and attract us.

ANNOUNCEMENT FROM THE SCA BOARD OF DIRECTORS

December 4, 2020

Greetings:

At the end of July, the Board of Directors issued a proclamation suspending most inperson SCA activities in North America until January 31, 2021, due to the COVID-19

global pandemic. In November, we asked the Kingdom Seneschals and Crowns of the known world to give us their counsel on how to proceed in the first part of 2021. We received very thoughtful responses from nearly all Crowns and Kingdom Seneschals as well as many other concerned people. We wish to thank everyone who responded for taking the time to do so, and for putting such effort into your responses.

After reading and discussing the feedback received, the Board decided at their conference call meeting on 12/01/2020 to continue the suspension of in-person activities in North America through May 31, 2021. That action reads as follows:

Motion by Ross Roegner to extend the Resolution to Suspend In-Person SCA Activity until January 31, 2021, originally issued by the Board of Directors on July 28, 2020, for a period of four (4) months, until May 31, 2021. Second by Gigi Coulson. Opposed: none. Absent: Jennifer Krochmal. Motion carried.

While there is good news on the horizon regarding effective vaccines and other ways to treat and manage COVID, implementation of those treatments is still in the future. The current situation shows that infection rates are continuing to increase in many places throughout North America. The most important concern at this time must be the safety of all participants. Please remember that federal, state, provincial, and local health directives and guidelines must continue to be followed whenever Kingdoms decide to authorize smaller local in-person meetings and local fighter practices. These local activities remain under the discretion of the Crown and Kingdom Seneschal. Kingdom Earl Marshals are welcome to give advice to the Crowns and Kingdom Seneschals when approving local practices.

Virtual events, as have been happening in many kingdoms, are of course allowed and encouraged to continue. If a Kingdom believes that the circumstances in their area allow for an in-person event, beyond approved local practices and meetings, to be held safely

before May 31, 2021, the Crown and Kingdom Seneschal are welcome to discuss a variance with the Society Seneschal.

Such variances for events beyond local practices and meetings will be considered, but please keep in mind that limits on participants, mask requirements, local government approval, insurance questions, vaccine availability, and actual conditions regarding the epidemic in the Kingdom requesting the variance are all important issues that will be considered and discussed for any requested variances prior to the May 31, 2021 date. Further, as stated in the original Resolution, if a Crown or Coronet feels the need to step down without heirs, a regent may be installed according to the laws of the kingdom or principality. If those laws are not adequate for the situation, the kingdom is invited to work with the Society Seneschal to create a solution that will be in the best interests of the kingdom or principality. Live events and personal interactions are a large part of the way the Society has continued over the last fifty-plus years. These restrictions on live events in the SCA are painful, but the state of the world, and the well-being of everyone involved, currently require we be as careful as possible. It does look like there will be vaccines available soon and once the epidemic is under some semblance of control, we can have live events again and celebrate all our interests and community safely.

From the Office of the Seneschal THL Reynhard von Reutte

Greetings!

I am sure that by now many of you are aware that there is a new seneschal in the barony of 1000 eyes. I am THL Reynard con Reutte and I am very pleased to be your new seneschal.

THL Sheelaegh has served in the role for two years and has done an admirable job in the position. I personally wish to applaud her and thank her for all her efforts. If you get the chance, please join me in congratulating her.

I realize that many of you do not know much about me and some of you do not know me at all so please allow me a few minutes to introduce myself. My wife and I moved to the Barony of 1000 Eyes a year ago, and we quickly fell in love with the warmth and welcome that is Artemisia and BOTE.

This will be my third opportunity to serve as seneschal. First, I served as the founding Seneschal for the canton of Ravenhyrst (mka Aurora, Colorado). I was tasked by the Baron and Baronial Seneschal to assess the need and desire for the formation of a canton and, if appropriate, to make the canton a reality. I obtained the written support of 96% of the populace in the proposed boundaries (over 100 members) and petitioned the Kingdom to bring the canton to reality.

Then I served as Seneschal for the Barony of Caerthe (mka Metro Denver area, Colorado). During my tenure, we lowered expenses by nearly half and grew a depleted bank account by 35%. Lead time for events also grew to a year out, resulting in higher attendance (one such event saw a 35% increase to over 400 people, after suffering a 10% plus decline for the previous 6 years).

When not serving as an officer I enjoy heavy fighting, archery and thrown weapons, cooking, and running events. And meeting so many awesome people who share in this crazy, wonderful Dream.

As a proponent of healthy growth, I intend to work hard to grow participation for the Barony of 1000 Eyes. Growth by its definition entails getting more people to participate. I need all of you to help with that. Please consider becoming more active with the Barony. Whether it is to become an officer, plan an event bid, or just reaching out to me with your opinions and ideas, I welcome your involvement.

COVID will soon be behind us. As we are all able to start meeting again in person and attending events, let's find a way for the Barony to hit the ground running. If we have not yet met, I look forward to meeting you. If we have met, I look forward to seeing you again ... soon!

Queen's Prize Artisan Display

Please plan to attend our (virtual) 2nd annual Queen's Prize Artisan Display

Queens Prize Artisan's Display held virtually at Masked Ball - January 23, 2020

Sponsors!!! Register your artisan(s) for the display!!!

What Is It?

Like the Laurel's Prize, these are non-judged artisan display where artisans typically sit with their work and are present for questions/kudos/etc. In this case, every artisan who displays is sponsored and the sponsor supplies a Prize for every artisan sponsored.

- How will we be doing this virtually this year?!?!
 - This year the display will be VIRTUAL (sadly... but we don't want to miss it!!)
 - The display will be held using Zoom Breakout Rooms, where artisans can go to a breakout room to show and tell and have smaller group discussions
 - Artisan's will need internet access and some form of camera to be able to display but this can be done using webcams or smartphone cameras. Anything works!! (Viewers of the display are not required to have cameras)
- Those with an A&S-type award of AoA level or below may be sponsored to display.
 - This only pertains to Arts & Sciences awards (e.g. a Knight of the SCA with a Golden Maple Leaf is eligible to display.)
- Those with an A&S-type award of GoA level or Laurels are the sponsors.
 - A person with a GoA level A&S type award may sponsor 2 artisans.
 - A Laurel may sponsor 4 artisans.
 - The Queen, or other key sponsor, may sponsor artisans as they and the event coordinator see fit.
 - Each sponsor must supply a prize for every artisan that they sponsor.
 - Sponsors can work with their sponsored artisans to help them be ready.

Every Artisan receives a prize

- Starting with the Queen (or key Sponsoring person) who awards a prize to whomever they would prefer.
- If there are other key sponsors, such as local Baronage, they might go next.
- All artisans not otherwise recognized is then called in random order to make a choice from the loot present.

Come ready for a great day!

- Recommending that Artisans bring 1-2 items (put your best foot forward!) But, since this is not a formally judged occasion, there isn't a hard limit
- No requirement for multiple categories.
- Documentation is not required (but totally welcome!)
- Display is open for all to view!



The Peacock's Pride is awarded to those of noble character, whose generosity to the Barony goes above and beyond all others. They are shining examples to us all. Companions of the Peacock's Pride deserve our utmost admiration and gratitude. It has been said that a Companion of the Peacock's Pride would leave a gaping void if they were to depart our fair Barony. They are true examples of Chivalry and Honor.
